Competition Class

The Competition will be arranged in Club, Standard, 15-meter, 18-meter and Open class. If less than 5 planes in one class, two or more classes can be merged according to rules stated in Local Procedures.

Total number of allowable entries: A maximum of 40 sailplanes

As per April 15 from the preliminary list of entries indicates that the competition will be arranged in 18-meter class and, according to Local Procedures, in a handicapped class. The final division into classes will be done according to the final entries.

Entry Fee
